

Ceremonies and Games-Time Volunteer Audition Opportunities!

Auditions to take place on Sunday, March 29, 2015.

B5C —creator and producer of the TORONTO 2015 Pan Am Closing Ceremony and the Parapan Am Opening and Closing Ceremonies — is seeking men and women ages 18 and up for exciting volunteer roles!

Taking place during the ceremonies as well as throughout the Games, these positions include Ceremonies Placard Bearers, Onstage Ceremonies Protocol Assistants, Medal Ceremony Traybearers and Athlete/Presenter Escorts, and more!

Audition Requirements:

- Be poised, photogenic, engaging, and able to walk to a beat while holding a prop.
- Adapt to changing stage/performance conditions, take direction and perform well under pressure, as well as being comfortable in front of large crowds and on live television.
- Specific dance experience is not a requirement. A very basic movement sequence will be taught. Performance experience, as well as past experience in sport or other ceremonies, is not required, but will be considered an asset.
- Ceremonies volunteers must reside in Toronto during the rehearsals and show dates.
- Ceremonies placard bearers and onstage ceremonies protocol assistants and other ceremonies volunteer performers will be required to be available for the following key rehearsal and show dates:

Show Dates:

Pan Am Closing Ceremony: July 26, 2015
Parapan Am Opening Ceremony: August 7, 2015
Parapan Am Closing Ceremony: August 15, 2015

Full cast rehearsals:

July 3 - 25, 2015
August 1 - 6, 2015
August 10 - 14, 2015

- Games-time volunteers **must** be available on each day of the Pan Am Games (July 10–26) and or all of the Parapan Am Games (August 7–15). Volunteers who are available for both Games will be given priority.

Important information to attend the audition:

1. You must register in order to attend the audition. [Register here](#). Once you've completed your registration, you will receive a confirmation email from Eventbrite. Please note: Your completed registration does NOT confirm an audition spot. If you are selected, you will receive an invitation to audition, with all the necessary information provided by email closer to the audition date.
2. You must be at least 18 years of age by the 3rd of July, 2015.
3. Wear dancewear or activewear and a pair of shoes you are comfortable moving in. Be well-groomed and "camera ready." You should wear clothing that is free of commercial branding.
4. If required, callbacks or interviews will take place on the same day as the audition. B5C recommends that you bring your lunch since the audition may take all day.
5. B5C will take photos of your face and full body as well as your costume measurements during check-in. *B5C will be collecting this information from everyone who auditions, whether you are cast or not.*
6. Please bring government-issued photo ID. You will also be asked to complete a registration form **prior** to arriving at the audition. This form is mandatory and includes information required to complete the TORONTO 2015 accreditation process.
7. Please note that neither B5C nor TO2015 will pay for any expenses incurred by volunteers participating in these auditions.
8. If selected, you agree to participate voluntarily in this project. You will not be given any monetary compensation for your participation.

Deadline for Registration

Registration will **close** on March 25, 2015 at midnight.
Audition space will be limited so please register early to
avoid disappointment!
